

Mountain Lakes Beach Rules

Hours:

- Beaches are open from sunrise until 11:00 PM
- Lifeguards are on duty from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM during the beach season
- Lifeguards are in charge of the beach while on duty

Residency Requirements:

- Beaches are open to residents and guests only
- Beach tags are required while lifeguards are on duty for any patron over 2 years of age
- Proof of residency is required at all other times

Children:

- All children 10 and under must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older while at the beach
- Children 10 to 12 years of age who have NOT passed the swim test must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older while at the beach
- Children 10 to 12 years of age who have passed the swim test and are wearing their swim badge do not need a chaperone

Swimming:

- Swim badges must be worn on the suit
- Swimmers 13 years of age and older, as well as swimmers 12 and under who have swim badges, may use deep water areas (swim lanes, rafts, and diving boards)
- Children 12 years of age and under without swim badges are restricted to water below their shoulder height
- No personal flotation devices of any kind (bubbles, vests, etc.) are permitted
- No running, pushing, or rough-housing on the beaches or docks

Prohibitions and Permits Year Round:

- No glass containers
- No alcoholic beverages
- No dogs permitted on the beach
- Special events require permits
- Group swim lessons are offered through Mountain Lakes Recreation. All other group swim lessons are prohibited
- Beach tags and privileges attached may be revoked for non-compliance with any of the above
