Dissolved oxygen discussed, scheduled hydroraking is our current approach for low levels.
Abandoned Beaver Lodging removal discussed, schedule for time when no juvenile beaver would be present.
Water Lilies in swim lanes will be addressed when permitting issues with hydroraking clarified. November hydroraking targeted for Birchwood.

Wildwood Lake:
Algae treated
Cattail removal will require land owner's permission for treatment

Mountain:
Treated for Water Clarity and Milfoil (minor)

Crystal:

Sunset:
